



To help speed up the registration process, please have all your forms filled out prior to arriving in the Parade Registration Staging Area.

NOTE: All forms will be available in the Staging Lanes if you have not been able to fill out the forms prior to your arrival.

PARADE REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Registration Takes Place 5pm-7pm on Thursday, February 12, 2015

- By snowmobile, follow the REGISTRATION signs to the Parade Registration Staging Area at the Canadian Tire Welcome Centre (Seniors Circle).
- 2. Parade volunteers will direct you into a parade staging lane.
- 3. You MUST STAY with your snowmobile until a Parade Registration Team has come to you and your snowmobile to officially process your registration. Please have all forms ready. Refer to Parade Registration Requirements at left for more details.
- 4. The Parade Registration Team will assign your Snowmobile Number and issue your Parade Registration Pass. Only one Parade Registration Pass will be issued per snowmobile. Once you have been successfully processed for the Guinness World Record count, you are free to leave your snowmobile and join the pre-parade social in the Canadian Tire Welcome Centre (Seniors Circle). There will be coffee, tea, hot chocolate, pop, and pizza available to purchase before and after the parade.
- 5. Please review the Parade Rules and Regulations below (and located on the back of your Parade Registration Pass). If you have any questions, please find a member of the Parade Registration Team.
- 6. You must be back to your snowmobile by 6:45pm in preparation to start the parade.
- 7. The parade will begin at 7pm.
- 8. The post-parade celebration will begin after the parade at 8pm.

PARADE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS Trail Pass or Day Pass Not Required

- 1. A PARADE REGISTRATION FORM must be filled out for EACH SNOWMOBILE to count towards the record. The Year, Make, Model and VIN # must be supplied for each snowmobile to meet the Guinness World Record requirements (exemption for antique snowmobiles).
- 2. All participants 18 years & older (both drivers and passengers) must sign a Waiver. 18+ Waiver included on Parade Registration Form.
- 3. All participants under 18 years old (drivers and passengers) must have a Parent/Guardian sign a Parent Acknowledgment & Release form.

PARADE RULES & REGULATIONS

- Only registered riders will be counted as participants in event.
- The matching number to the Parade Registration Pass will be provided in the staging area and must be displayed on the windshield for the duration of the event.
- Riders must remain in a single file line for the entire duration of the record attempt from the exit of the staging area to the entrance of the staging area upon return. Participants are NOT permitted to pass other participants at any time.
- Riders MUST NOT exceed a distance of two snowmobile lengths apart during the parade.
- All snowmobiles must cross the start line and drive the length of the route to the finish line to be included in the final count. (All riders must return to their original line ups in staging area.)
- In the event that a snowmobile malfunctions, riders are asked to move their snowmobiles to the side of the parade route so record attempt may continue.
